NSS Volunteers actively participated in poster pasting and dissemination of budget awareness messages. Teaching and non-teaching staff also extended their support to make the programme successful.

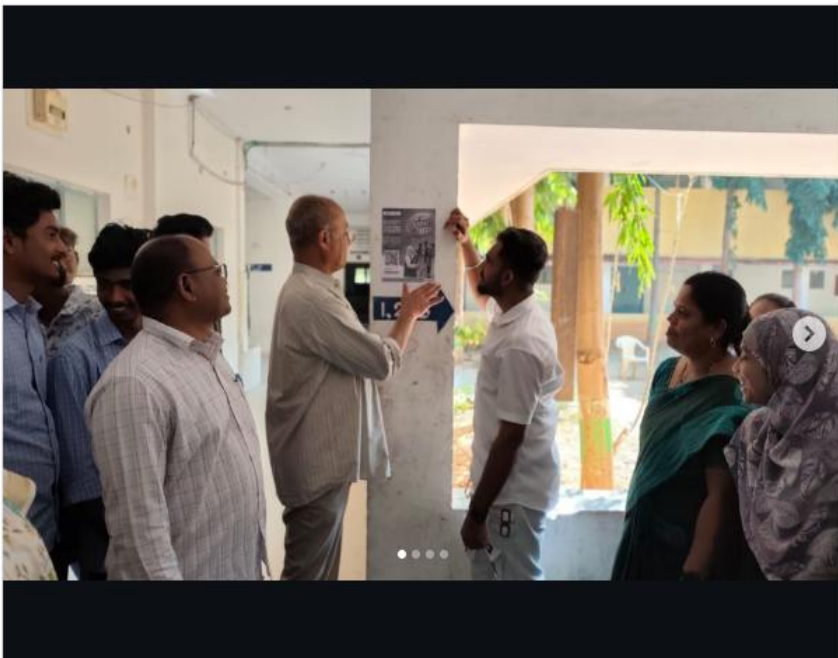
The initiative aimed to create awareness among students about the national budget, its impact on society, and the role of youth in understanding economic policies.
