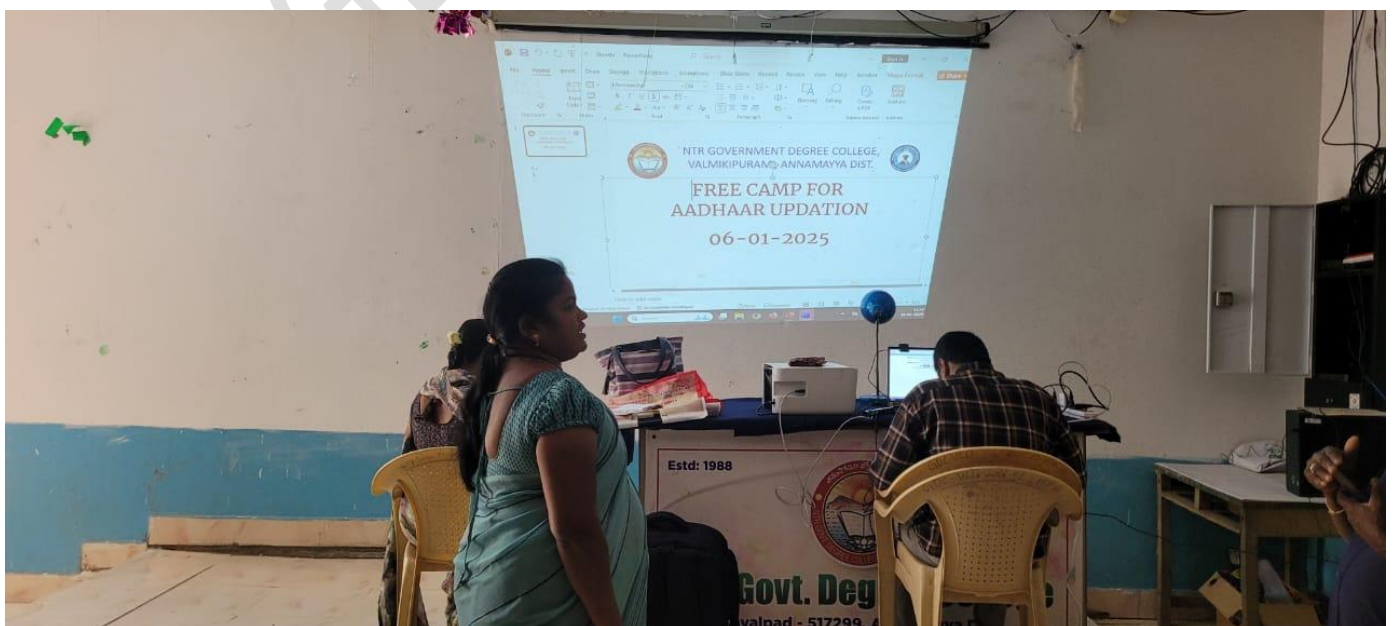
FREE CAMP FOR AADHAAR UPDATION

REPUBLIC DAY CELEBRATIONS

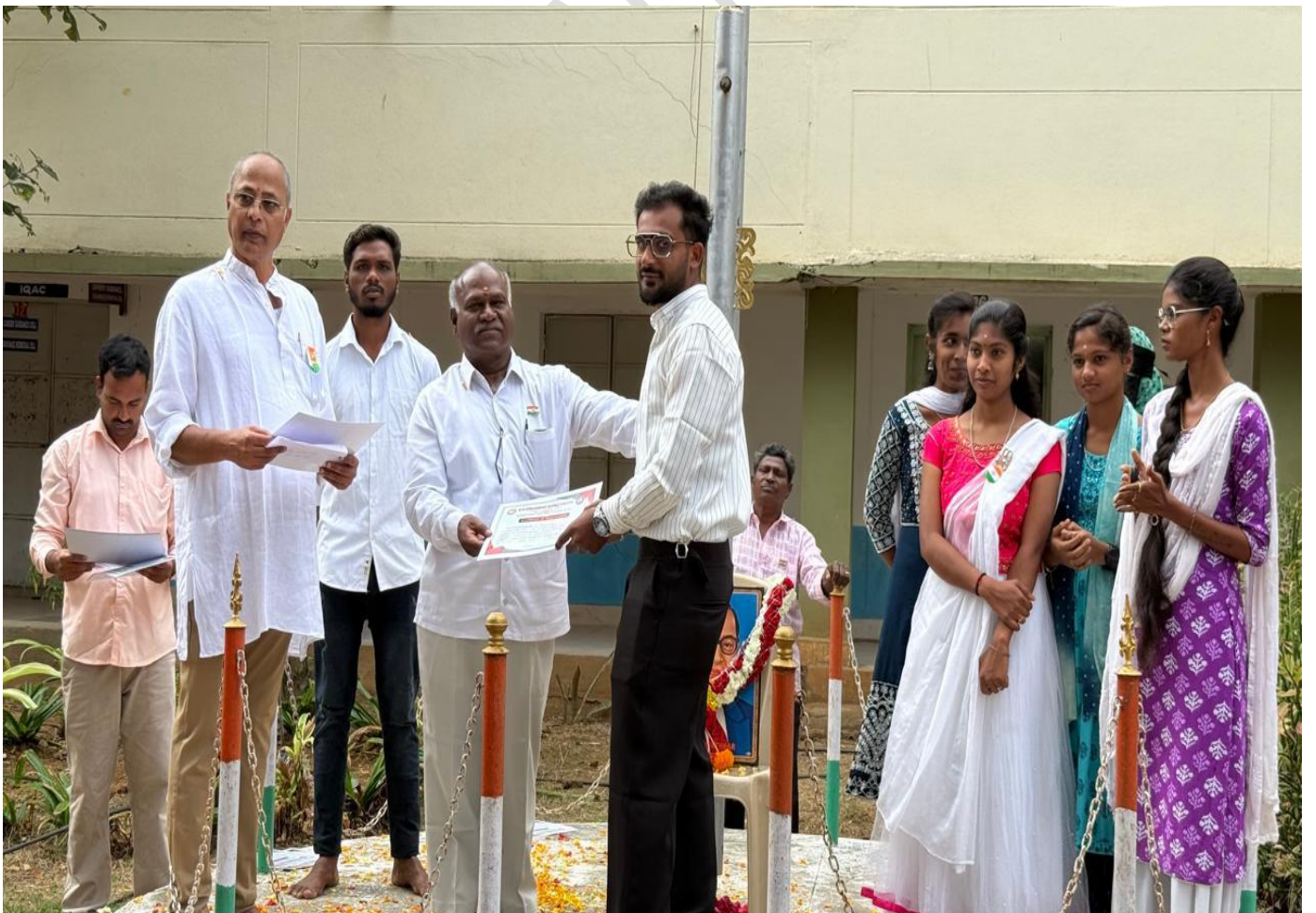
